Sensors, Distributed, Modular and Wireless Systems

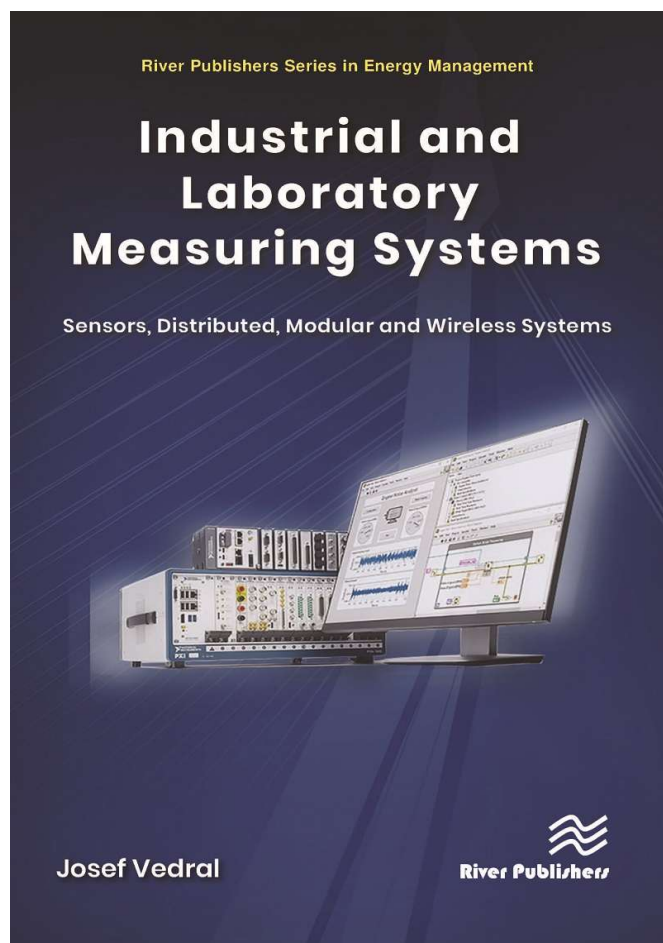

The final chapters describe methods of digitization, reconstruction and signal processing in measurement systems in time and frequency domains.
