

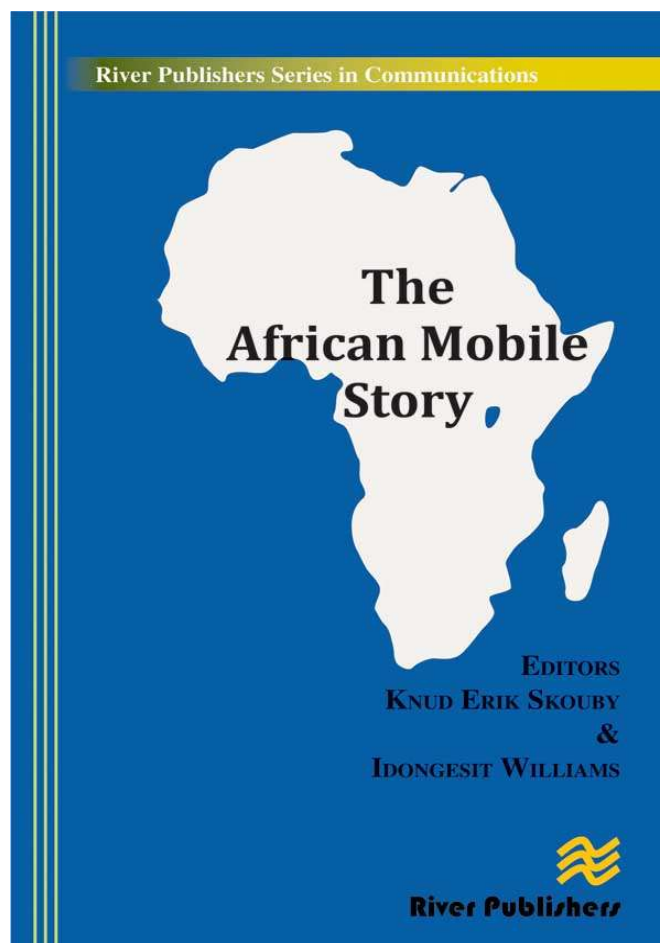
The African Mobile Story
